The Department of Natural Resources and Environment will lease its entire Lake St. Helen launch, parking facility and land to Richfield Township under a "25-Year Zero Dollar Renewable Lease" by Oct. 2010, meeting one of the requirements for the Township to apply for a grant covering 75% of the pier project cost. The Township must provide the 25% match, and has teamed up with the St. Helen Lake Assn. to spearhead local fundraising efforts.
